(Week 2 & 3, January 6 & 13) *God will accomplish his purposes*

Isaiah 46:9-10

I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is none like me, declaring the end from the beginning and from ancient times things not yet done, saying, "My counsel shall stand, and I will accomplish all my purpose"

(Week 4 & 5, January 20 & 27) *God will forgive your sins*

1 John 1:9

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

(Week 6 & 7, February 3 & 10) *God will always be with you*

Hebrews 13:5-6

For he has said, "I will never leave you nor forsake you." So we can confidently say, "The Lord is my helper; I will not fear; what can man do to me?"

(Week 8 & 9, February 17 & 24) *Nothing can separate you from God's love*

Romans 8:38-39

For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord.

(Week 12 & 13, March 16 & 23) *God will sanctify you completely*

1 Thessalonians 5:23-24

Now may the God of peace himself sanctify you completely, and may your whole spirit and soul and body be kept blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. He who calls you is faithful; he will surely do it.

(Week 14 & 15, March 30 & April 6) *God will answer your prayers*

John 15:7

If you abide in me, and my words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you.

(Week 16 & 17, April 13 & 20) *God will not withhold good from you*

Psalm 84:11

For the LORD God is a sun and shield; the LORD bestows favor and honor. No good thing does he withhold from those who walk uprightly.

(Week 18 & 19, April 27 & May 4) *God will strengthen you*

Isaiah 40:29-31

He gives power to the faint, and to him who has no might he increases strength. Even youths shall faint and be weary, and young men shall fall exhausted; but they who wait for the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles; they shall run and not be weary; they shall walk and not faint.

(Week 20 & 21, May 11 & 18) *God will strengthen you*

2 Chronicles 16:9

For the eyes of the LORD run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to give strong support to those whose heart is blameless toward him.

(Week 22 & 23, May 25 & June 1) *God will be with you in the hard times*

Isaiah 41:10

Fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God; I will strengthen you, I will help you, I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.

(Week 24 & 25, June 8 & 15) *God's mercies never end*

Lamentations 3:22-23

The steadfast love of the LORD never ceases; his mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning; great is your faithfulness.

(Week 26 & 27, June 22 & 29) *God will not bring any unnecessary suffering into your life*

Lamentations 3:32-33

But, though he cause grief, he will have compassion according to the abundance of his steadfast love; for he does not willingly afflict or grieve the children of men.

(Week 28 & 29, July 6 & 13) *God rewards those who persevere*

James 1:12

Blessed is the man who remains steadfast under trial, for when he has stood the test he will receive the crown of life, which God has promised to those who love him.

(Week 30 & 31, July 20 & July 27) *God will give you rest*

Matthew 11:28-29

Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.

(Week 32 & 33, August 3 & 10) *God will be faithful to the end*

Isaiah 46:4

Even to your old age I am he, and to gray hairs I will carry you. I have made, and I will bear; I will carry and will save.

(Week 34 & 35, August 17 & August 24) *God will provide all your needs*

Romans 8:32

He who did not spare his own Son but gave him up for us all, how will he not also with him graciously give us all things?

(Week 36 & 37, August 31 & September 7) *God will provide all your needs*

Philippians 4:19

And my God will supply every need of yours according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus.

John 14:2-3
